- All players will be responsible for individual registration with USA Hockey. Electronic registration with USA Hockey begins, April 1, 2010. Proof of registration must be submitted to the Pond Penguins at evaluations. **NO** one will be allowed to skate without the USA Hockey confirmation page. All checks should be made out to The Pond Ice Arena. Credit Cards are accepted for payment 3% fee added to each cc purchase, AMEX 5%.

Who are the Pond Penguins?

The Pond Penguins are a Youth Ice Hockey club that skates out of the Pond Ice Arena in Newark, DE. The Penguins compete against teams in Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Maryland. The Penguins sponsor travel ice hockey teams in the Mite division only. Once a player has completed the Mite level, by a age nine years, they move to the Delaware Ducks Program.
